

Nine Days in Kenya and its Wildlife Parks

Complete Itinerary & Activity Plan

The following is a sample itinerary and subject to change.

DAY ONE:

Today our adventure begins! On arriving at Nairobi International Airport, you will be greeted by one of our drivers and taken to our hotel. Relax and unwind after your flight with a drink and dinner outside on the hotel deck while meeting the group that you will be adventuring with in the days to come. After dinner, Jen and Camille will give a lecture, giving you photography tools you can use on the journey ahead!

DAY TWO:

After breakfast in Nairobi, we will begin our safari with a drive to the famous Masai Mara. See the Great Rift Valley unfold on this scenic drive and keep an eye out for wildlife outside of the park. When we arrive in the evening we will have our very first game drive in the epic Masai Mara.

Our 4x4 safari vehicles will have plenty of space with a maximum of four photographers per vehicle. Jen and Camille will be rotating which vehicle they are in, so they can help with any technical or creative questions you may have.



DAY THREE AND FOUR:

After breakfast, we will for our first full day of game drives in the famous Maasai Mara. It is one of Africa's greatest wildlife reserves and is famous for the abundance of lion, it's without a doubt one of Africa's most famous safari destinations. The Maasai stretches 1,510 sq. km and offers the best game and bird viewing not only in Kenya but in Africa. The views across the rolling golden grasslands studded with acacia trees, rivers and forests offer a dazzling vistas and overwhelming sense of space. We will spend as much time as we can inside the park on these days, taking tons of photos.

In the evenings you will have time for one on ones with Camille and Jen. These one on ones help you on an individual level to make sure you get the best possible photos on your adventure. No need to edit your work, we want to see all your raw files from the first days on safari, that way we can see all the successful images and help with any advice on how to get more impactful images.

DAY FIVE:

Today starts with a sunrise hot air balloon over the Masai Mara. Have a bird's eye view of the animals in the park as the first rays of sunlight come out. Celebrate your morning with a champagne breakfast in the game park. Finish off the day with another game drive in the park followed by a class in the evening by Jen and Camille.



DAY SIX:

After breakfast the hotel will transfer you to the airstrip for your flight to Tsavo. On arrival you will be transferred to our hotel followed by lunch. Tsavo East National Park is one of the world's largest game reserves at over 13,000 square kilometers. Tsavo East is not only home to its famous maneless male lions, it boasts one of the most diverse populations of wildlife in the world. Safari during the day, then image share and critiques at night.

DAY SEVEN:

Today is a full day of game drives at Tsavo East National Park. A variety of animals can be seen in the park such as lions, leopard, cheetah, zebras, giraffes, serval cats, antelopes, kongoni, lesser kudu, Oryx, klipspringer, impala, striped hyena, ostriches, gazelles, buffaloes, elephants and many more. A variety of migratory and native birds are seen. Tsavo East is famous for the 'Man-eaters'. In 1898, as many as 135 railway workers were attacked and killed by man-eating lions.

Our lodge, Voi Safari Lodge, sits inside the park and has its own hide to photograph elephants at the watering hole. In the evening we will have dinner together on the large balcony watching the sunset over the savanna. Over dinner there will be time to share your stories and favorite images with the group.



DAY EIGHT:

Today, we have a full day of game driving in Tsavo West! The expansive and diverse landscape is home to many of Africa's great wildlife including lions, buffalo, cheetah, giraffe, zebras, hippo, and wildebeest. The Mzima Springs are fed daily by 250 million liters of water pouring from the Chyulu Hills and provide an oasis of lush vegetation which is home to several species of monkey, birds, hippo and crocodile. We will spend the afternoon exploring the springs from the walkable nature trails and view hippo from the underwater viewing chamber.

The Park is a vast expansion of African savanna with a more diverse array of habitats which include open plains, semi desert scrub, woodland, the Chyulu Hills and rock outcrops. It's famous for the Red Elephants, Oryx, and Gerenuk among other mammal's species and bird life. From water to fire, the park is home to the Mzima Springs as well as the Shetani Lava Flow and Ash cones (from a recent volcanic eruption).

DAY NINE:

After a leisurely breakfast we will bid farewell to all the amazing wildlife and depart for Nairobi. On arrival you'll be transferred to the airport for your flight back home with full memory cards, new friends and lots of new stories!
